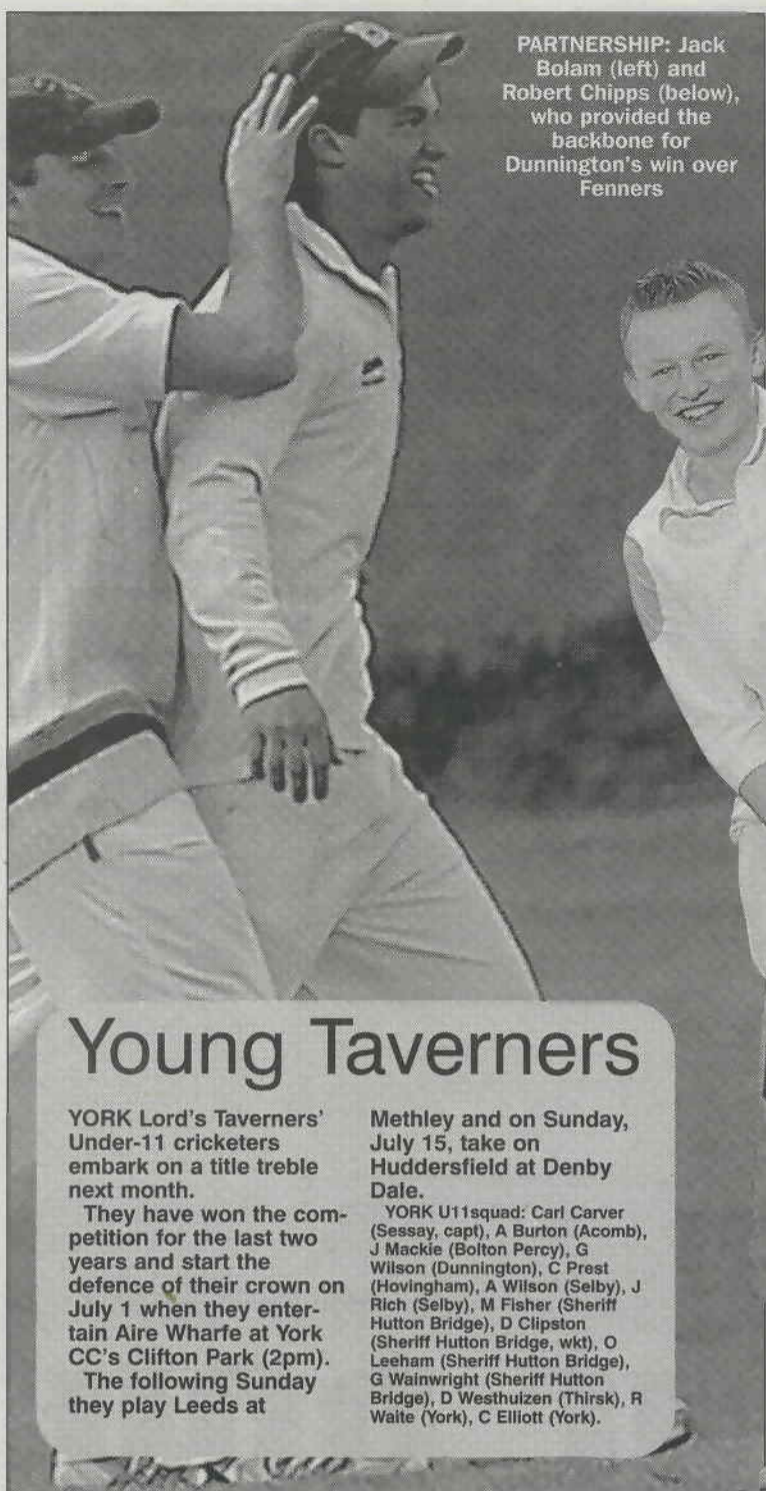

Dunnington pair hammer Hull

ALL-ROUNDER Rob Chipps starred as York and District Senior Cricket League's Intermediate Section champions Dunnington began the defence of their title with victory over Fenners.

The Hull side's bowlers were taken to task by Chipps (63) and 19-year-old Jack Bolam, who scored 49 as Dunnington totalled 178. Chipps, three years younger than Bolam, then took 3-23 as Fenner's innings closed on 139 in 37 overs.

Hull Zingari's teenage opener Matthew Bunn recorded the league's first ever century when he made an unbeaten 101 as his side trounced Goole Town by 152 runs.

Three figure scores are hard to come by due to the league's requirement that batsmen retire when they reach 50 and are only able to resume at the end of the innings.

Dringhouses marked their debut game in the competition with a four-wicket win

at Londesbrough Park. The section is designed to give younger players a chance with each team being restricted in the number of senior players they can field.

Londesborough were dismissed for 126 as Sam Lingard claimed 4-23 and Dringhouses' run-chase was led by Chris Storey (30) and John Patrick (28) on their way to a four-wicket win.

Woodhouse Grange, zonal winners in 2006, lost to a Thirsk side containing eight players under 15 and three 12-year-olds. Grange made 134-9 but Thirsk skipper Anthony Elders made 52 retired and Jamie Howe (41) led their side's victory charge in the face of some excellent bowling by

Scott Shepherd, aged 12, who took 5-9 in three overs.

Two 15-year-olds made decent scores when York batted first at Selby with Kylie Waite making 33 and Adam Davies 34no to help York to 171-8. Selby's reply started badly as three wickets fell for only 13 runs with James Murphy making early inroads. Sam Cruise made 27 but Murphy, aged 15, went on to grab 5-9 in 7.3 overs as Selby were bowled out for 121.

Malton and Old Malton's young batsmen all contributed to their five-wicket win at Stamford Bridge with victory coming in the 33rd over.

Fifteen-year-old all-rounder David Phillips starred in the combined Sheriff Hutton Bridge and Rowntree's side's four-wicket victory at Hornsea, taking 4-43 and scoring an unbeaten 36.

Heworth drew with Welton & Brough, with two teenagers taking the eye for the Elm Park Way side.

Sixteen-year-old wicketkeeper-batsman Steve Clarke made 43 and partnered Graham Knott, aged 18, in a 94-run second wicket stand with the latter retiring on 50.
