It has, for many years, provided an introduction to the game for local children. Many of these have gone on to represent the adult teams and to play for local representative teams.

The club has expanded recently and now runs 9 sides in the York & District Cricket Leagues. In recent years the First XI has been very successful, winning the Premier League title & League Cup on several occasions. The Junior section has expanded, two Under 9 teams were created in 2007 and an Intermediate (U18) team was created in 2005 and won the title the following season. We now provide competitive cricket & coaching to over 70 juniors. To facilitate this growth, we have invested in the provision of qualified coaches. To date 9 volunteers have become ECB Level 2 qualified coaches and they run sessions throughout the summer and also in the winter at the Indoor Cricket Centre.
