MATTERS ARISING FROM FEBRUARY MEETING

The Joe Lumb Competition will be League based this year.

It was agreed that Alan Fletcher is to liaise with Peter Northfield and Shane Hargrave from York Vale League to get them involved from next season, perhaps invite them to one of the games.

UPDATE ON GROUP DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Lengthy discussions took place regarding the plan. All agreed that it would probably work better if some of the sub sections were merged into others so it would be easier on the people designated to the particular section.

There the decision was taken to condense the plan; Mick Pickering offered to work out the new plan layout for the next meeting.

- A Cricket Advocacy needs to be appointed as soon as possible.

- (b) Formalisation of Club/School Links is to be merged with (c) Club Development/Clubmark Accreditation
- (g) Developing Officials and Administrators is to be merged with (h) Developing Volunteers, Continuous Professional Development
- (a) Attendance and Membership is to be merged with (i) Increase Participation
- (e) Facility Development and (k) Investment Plan and External Funding are also to be merged.
- (d) Player Development is to remain a stand alone item
- (f) Coach Development is also to remain as a stand alone item

BANK ACCOUNT UPDATE + FINANCIAL POSITION

Bernard reported in his absence that the Current Account Balance stood at £4018.28. Of which £3521 is set aside for advance payments towards the 2008 Level 2 Coaching Course. This will leave us with a balance of £497.28.

He stated that only 4 clubs had paid their £5 subscription for this year and the rest need to pay as soon as possible.

The Awards for All application is progressing slowly mainly due to requests for forms being ignored, hoping to receive the application pack within the week.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

There are no immediate plans for Short Umpires and Scorers Courses until after the season.

There is some money left over from The Coaching Course from the winter. Mick Pickering suggests that everybody that has taken part over the last two years should have the chance to attend a coaching day to be arranged later this year with the money that is left over.

Mick Morgan in the Indoor Cricket Centre at Dunnington is to hold some Cricket Workshops October/November time on a Saturday or Sunday.

Alan Fletcher reported that 4 Sundays in January 4/11/18/25 are to set aside for the 2009 Coaching Course. The Mount School is the preferred location.

Mick Pickering reported that the Clubmark workshops have been successful and the final phase is to be held at St Johns College.

Mick Kenyon asked the question, Can a youngster score without CRB checks or does he/she have to go through the process of applying.
Mick Pickering said he would investigate.

Mike Meek reported that the Craig White Cricket Academy event that was held at Oaklands recently, went well. He did comment also that the netting facility at Oaklands was poor.
